Arizona landscape and wildlife photographer, **Barbara Cox**, will be exhibiting some of her original photography at the Mountain Brew Coffee House at 6832 South Kings Ranch Rd. in Gold Canyon, AZ from January 11 until February 14, 2011. Her photography includes not only landscapes of Arizona and some wildlife from throughout the 50 states she's visited, but also floral images she has captured on her extensive travels.

In addition, Barbara will be conducting a "meet and greet" event at the coffee shop on Saturday, January 15, 2011, between 10 am and 3 pm. She will be available to answer questions about her photography and will have additional work available for the public to view and purchase, including her prints of various sizes as well as her greeting cards which is what initiated her entry into the art world.

Those visiting the coffee shop will find a variety of hot and cold beverages available as well as *paninis*, sandwiches and juices, all served in a pleasant, quiet atmosphere surrounded by art from several local artists. Julio and Deana Najera, the owners, are very supportive of the arts and have ongoing displays in their new shop. Their hours on Saturday are from 6 am until 3 pm.

Barbara has been taking photographs since she was a young child, growing up in Ohio. After moving to Arizona in the 1990's, her interest blossomed as she began to capture the beauty throughout the state of Arizona. One of her best-known photographs is called, "Reflection on the 18th Green," an image of Superstition Mountain reflected in the pond on the 18th green at Superstition Mountain Golf Course. It shows the power of the mountain as well as its character reflected on the water in the late afternoon.

Barbara has been exhibiting her photography in several locations throughout Pinal, Gila and Maricopa Counties in recent years. She lives in Roosevelt, Arizona and is a member of the Artists of the Superstitions as well as the Cobre Valley Center for the Arts in Globe. She looks forward to visiting with friends, old and new on Saturday, January 15 between the hours of 10 am and 3 pm.
